LOUISVILLE ON TAP BRINGS TOP CRAFT BEERS TO DOWNTOWN LOUISVILLE

LOUISVILLE, KY (January 14, 2016) – Louisville On Tap is coming to the Kentucky International Convention Center Saturday, January 23, offering beer-enthusiasts the opportunity to try more than 100 different types of beer in one location. With beer, food and live music, the event offers a great evening in downtown Louisville.

Louisville On Tap will feature beers from a variety of breweries, including some of the best craft brews in the country. Local breweries including Falls City, Cumberland Brewing, Goodwood Brewing will be joined by additional breweries such as Magic Hat, New Belgium, Sierra Nevada and West Sixth.

Live music will feature the Greg Finger Band, an Americana band based out of Lexington, KY that combines the musical styles of folk, country, blues and pop.

Tickets are \$45 for standard admission, which includes three hours of beer sampling, a souvenir glass and live music. VIP admission is \$65 and includes early admission, four hours of beer sampling, a souvenir glass, t-shirt, food voucher and live music. Doors open at 4:00 p.m. for VIP admission and are open from 5:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.
