## **BUILD: WHAT'S GOING UP**

Building temporary walls at exhibit hall in east building (bordered by Jefferson, Market, Second and Third Streets) exhibit hall.

Erecting structural braces in east building exhibit hall, can begin truss demo of west building when completed.

Completed: Temporary equipment and piping for HVAC to east building: chilled water system now feeding existing east building.

## **DEMO: WHAT'S COMING DOWN**

Tearing out overhead ceilings and mechanical, electrical and plumbing systems in west building exhibit hall and Cascade Ballroom.

Removing brick and stone from building exterior for use on new building.

Transporting materials that have been removed for recycling.

Removing exterior canopies for west end of west building, continuing interior demolition.

Completed: Jefferson Street Hyatt Pedway demolition

## **STREET-WISE:**

Temporary 4<sup>th</sup> Street traffic lights at Market and Jefferson Streets.

## **SAFETY: PASSERSBY & WORKERS**

**Warning: It is unsafe for the public to walk along the jersey barriers on Jefferson, Market and Third Streets. Pedestrians should use sidewalks.**

As of this reporting, no accidents or incidents have occurred at the worksite.

Security is now at Jefferson and Market Streets on the west side of Third Street, for contractors to access the work site. For meetings in the east building, use the Second Street side of KICC/HUNT's entry.
